



## *Rogersville Tinsel Trail* – Guidelines for decorating your tree

- We will provide each sponsor/decorator with one live Fraser Fir Christmas tree and signage listing the sponsor/decorator. Sponsors/decorators must provide decorations and outdoor LED lighting for their tree. We reserve the right to remove any lighting that is not outdoor LED lighting.
- Our trees will measure between 5-6 feet in height. Due to offering live Fraser Firs, we cannot guarantee the width or shape of every tree.
- Tree selection is on a first come, first serve basis. When you arrive to decorate your tree (see attached dates and times to decorate), you must check-in with a Town of Rogersville employee. An employee will either be at Heritage Park or at Town Hall. At check-in, a town employee will approve your lights and decorations. You will receive your sponsorship sign and then be able to select your tree.
- If sponsors/decorators plan on using other décor items around their trees (props, reindeer, etc.) they must be approved beforehand via email to [l.owens@townofrogersvilleal.com](mailto:l.owens@townofrogersvilleal.com) or by bringing a picture to Rogersville Town Hall. Drilling into the ground is NOT allowed.
- Ladders will NOT be provided to sponsors/decorators.
- Edible items will NOT be allowed to be used for decorations (candy canes, popcorn, birdseed, etc.). They attract wildlife and compromise the safety of the environment.
- It can get windy and rainy on the *Tinsel Trail*. Please secure all decorations to your tree using pipe cleaners, small zip ties, or other string/ties. Ornament hooks/wire can be used if the ends are secure. The Town of Rogersville is NOT responsible for lost or stolen decorations.
- *Tinsel Trail* is a family friendly display. Please no offensive or inappropriate décor. We reserve the right to remove offensive displays.

If the décor is not removed by 5:00 PM on Friday, January 8<sup>th</sup>, all decorations will go into the recycle or garbage.
